This gun is about eight years
old, since the beginning, I have had problems
with it, which seem to get worst as
time goes on. Each time I have
brought it back to a Remington Repair
Center and no one can seem to fix
it once and for all.

They have adjusted the trigger
a number of times, because the bolt
would not cock when opened, also
on cold days in the field the bolt
would not cock, bring it in to a warm
building and the problem doesn't happen.
At times if you released the safety the
bolt would fall and the gun would
go off.

Now I take the gun out for the
first time this year to sight it in
for my elk hunt and we are getting light
hits on the primer.

every year I used this gun it seems
to be a problem. I hope you people
can repair it once on for all.

PS
first year it let me down I was 20
miles by horse in elk County and the
follower cracked.

second year the trigger started act-
ing up

Third year Arty would ^{not} operate correctly
so rather than go to a service center
I am sending you the gun.
