I am returning this Remington Model 700, .30-06 caliber rifle, # 6846400 for your inspection. Please contact me after you have inspected this gun and located the problem.

On my last hunting trip, about ten days ago, I had a very disturbing thing happen. I entered my stand and proceeded to load my rifle. I layed the barrel across a rest and inserted three bullets into the bottom of the gun. I moved the bolt forward advancing the first bullet into the chamber. When I moved the bolt forward and locked it down the gun fired, I never touched the trigger, I simply advanced the bolt. The shot went directly over the top of my hunting partners Jeep.

This gun was given to me by my parents as a gift in 1975 and I have only hunted with it about 10 or 15 times. I realize how dangerous this weapon is in it's current conditon and cannot imagine that any gun, at any age, could do this.
