Near Remington Arms,

I have had .308 Remington, 25.06 gauge that I bought from you back in the mid-70's. It is superb with a 1/4 mile field of the same year.

This has always been my "old Faithful" whitetail/mule deer gun, it has put many deer on the ground. It has always been reliable.

But, this year I crawled across a fence about 12 miles South of Pecos Springs Colorado. After crossing the fence and getting situated I loaded my rifle and when I closed the bolt, it decapitated a small pine tree above me. After sitting down from the unexpected shot and the color came back. I unloaded the clip. I dry fired it about 8 or 10 times closing the bolt, not even touching the trigger. If you remove the bolt and put it on safety it wouldn't discharge as you closed the bolt.

After the 3 or 4 dry fires it quit doing it and resumed normal operation and has worked fine everytime since. But you know I will never be able to trust that gun again. Is there anything that can be done to insure that this problem will not reoccur? Please Respond.
