Yesterday, 3-31-92, I purchased this Model 700 Mountain Rifle, Ser# B6778078 from a friend who just didn't use it. I think he bought it 3 years ago, but as you can see, it was used sparingly. I have not shot it yet. While working the action and putting the safe on and off, several times the action "fired" as I took the safe off (pushed forward). This could be deadly if it happened when it was loaded. My friend said he hadn't noticed it, but one time when he was finished hunting the rifle discharged when he took the safe off. Luckily it was pointed in a safe direction.

I thought about taking the rifle to a gunsmith, but the dealer where the rifle was bought suggested contacting (over)

you.

While this rifle may not have been recalled, I believe the condition has existed since it was made and hope it is under warrantee.

As you examine it, it may not "go off" when you first try it but I've had it happen as many as 3 times in a row. It seems like, for some reason, forward pressure on the safe sometimes causes the sear to drop.

I hope you can help me, because I've saved a long time and have wanted a rifle this nice for a long time.

Please contact me as soon as you can, and again, thank you very much.
