Sent Gun in for safety bolt/lock recall in December of 2003.
After receiving rifle back I remounted scope and fired approx. 1
box of shells through it to resight scope.

Used gun during the October moose season and took a nice cow
with one shot.

Did not clean gun before November deer season as this was only
weeks away.

Opening day of deer season temperature was about 25 degrees I
shot at a buck at 8: am and missed with the first shot. Cycled
another shell into the gun and when I tried to shoot again nothing
happened. Emptied this shell and remainder in magazine onto the
ground with none of the shells firing. I looked the gun over and
realized the trigger was still in the all the way back position. I
fiddled with the safety and put another shell in the gun, when I
closed the bolt the gun discharged. (safety was in the off position) I
again put another shell in this time with the safety in the on
position and nothing happened when I closed the bolt this time.
During all of this the deer remained in sight and I was able to
harvest it with the last bullet I had put in the gun.

Called your support people and they wanted the gun back for
another inspection.
