I bought a Remington 700 bolt action 30-06 rifle, serial # C6346656 in October of 1989 from Wal-Mart in Spartanburg, S.C.

On November 27, 1991 while deer hunting, a deer came within firing range. I pushed the safety switch to fire, raised the gun and got the deer in my sight and pulled the trigger. The gun did not fire. I lowered the gun and checked the safety switch, it was in the firing position. When I touched the safety switch the gun went off in my hands.

I now feel the gun is unsafe and I am afraid to use it as I do not trust it any longer.

I contacted Wal-Mart and they suggest that I write to you.

I am not at all satisfied with the performance of this gun. I have owned other Remington guns in the past that I feel were exceptional, but this one has not lived up to my expectations.

I feel this is a very serious and dangerous situation. What is your suggestion? Can you please help me with this problem?
