

I am the owner of a 30-06 SPRG Model 700 Serial No. 6815726. Ilion. N.York.
My son Les Hell a career serviceman for 14 years with the U.S. Army
at Fort Leonardwood Mo. came home for hunting and was using this gun,
when he put the safety on, the gun discharged just missing his foot
and damaging the pick up. He was very concerned as myself about
the safety of this weapon. I would like to know why these dangerous
guns were not recalled or owners notified about this hazard. I have
informed the Consumer Protection Agency and contacted my Attorney,
who advised me to contact the company to inform you of the hazard
that took place and to see what action you will take. I assure you
that I do not take this matter lightly and will take any action
that maybe required. I am now aware of a television report on the
safety of the model 700. It is very sad that consumers must watch
T.V. to get information on deadly weapon's. This gun was used very
little, probably fortunate, as it could have caused a fatal accident.
This gun should not be in anyone's possession. Let me hear from you.
