DENNIS, I AM SENDING BACK MY REMINGTON MOD. 7 IN 243 CAL. TO BE CHECKED FOR SAFETY. I PURCHASED THE WEAPON ON NOVEMBER OF 2000. THIS WAS 3 DAYS PRIOR TO DEER SEASON IN MY HOME STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA. I TOOK THE WEAPON TO THE RANGE AND ATTEMPTED TO CHAMBER A REMINGTON 100 GRAIN CORELOC CARTRIDGE, THE BOLT WOULD NOT CLOSE SO I TRIED ANOTHER CARTRIDGE FROM THE SAME BOX, STILL WOULD NOT CLOSE. I THEN GOT A DIFFERENT BOX OF REM. 100 GRAIN CORELOC WITH A DIFFRENT LOT #. THE BOLT STILL WOULD NOT CLOSE SO I PUSHED HARD AND THE BOLT CLOSED AND THE WEAPON DISCHARGED. I THEN TOOK SOME GUN-SMITHING TOOLS AND FILED THE AREA NEAR THE BOLT FACE AND EXTRACTOR AND STONED IT UNTIL IT WORKED. IT SEEMS TO BE WORKING FINE NOW. I FEEL REMINGTON STAFF SHOULD HAVE CAUGHT THIS AT THE FACTORY. DO THEY EVEN TEST THESE WEAPONS ? I ALSO HAD TO REMOVE THE SCOPE/MOUNTS TO SEND THIS WEAPON BACK.
