Please find me 700 B&F 7MM Mag. Ser # A6831417
for repair.

In late Oct. of 93 I went on a moose hunt to
Newfoundland. After 14 days of severe cold & rain every
day, a porcupine ran in to the bull I wanted, at about
90 yards. At this point I pushed my safety on fire
and tried to pull the trigger, nothing happened.
I pulled the trigger equal to 20 lbs of pressure.
The next thing I did was to put the safety
on safe. I inspected the gun the best I
could. I tried to breath on the bolt
to un freeze it. Then I tried to shoot
the moose again. I pushed the safety
on fire. At this point the gun fired on
its own without my finger on the
trigger. This drove the safety through my
thumb. I borrowed a Remington-700 Richardson
45-70 to shoot a moose the next day.

When I got back home I tested the gun in the
cold. It would not work, it would only work
at above 30° temp. I've used the gun since the
late '70's and never had a problem. I never had any
trigger work done to it. I took the gun apart
to take a look. I noticed set screws on the trigger
assembly were loose so I lock-tited them in.

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I haven't fired the gun since. I do
not trust it. I am disappointed that I didn't
shoot my moose with my ~~own~~ own gun.
but I am glad I did not shoot the guide.

If the problem is the trigger group could
you replace it with the best one you make.
