Dear Dennis,

Per instructions from Tommy Nagle I am enclosing my Model 600, .243 caliber, serial no. 93550 for repair. I recently went on a writing assignment trip to Wyoming to hunt both prairie dogs and Merriam turkeys using the Model 600. Prior to the trip I fired approximately 10 rounds to sight the gun in.

When I uncased the gun in Wyoming for the prairie dog hunt I check the gun before the hunt and found the following problem. After closing the bolt I moved the safety to the firing position and the firing pin released just as if I had pulled the trigger. I reset the bolt several other times and it again happened each time. That evening I tried it again and it worked several times and then the problem started again.
