My Remington 700 BDL 30-06 (enclosed) fired while moving the safety from Safe to Fire.
Fortunately, no one was hurt.

I was on a hunting trip in Wyoming with my father, brother, nephew, and a good friend the first week in November 1994. While hunting Deer and Antelope I had an opportunity to shoot at an Antelope and when I was ready to shoot and moved the safety from Safe to Fire, the gun went off. I missed my opportunity for this Antelope and was concerned for my safety and the safety of my hunting companions. I had to borrow another gun for the remainder of the trip.

I have hunted for over 25 years and have never had any guns which I felt were unsafe, however, after this experience with my Remington 700 BDL 30-06, I do not feel that it is safe to use anymore.

I would appreciate a replacement rifle which I can feel safe using again.
