On Sunday, March 20th, I saw a report on 60 Minutes concerning these rifles misfiring. One man lost his foot during one of these mishaps.

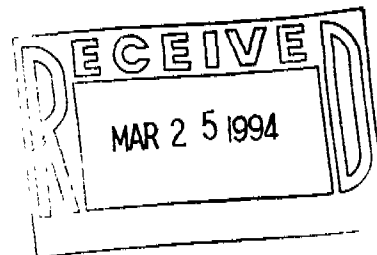

I appreciate your prompt response.

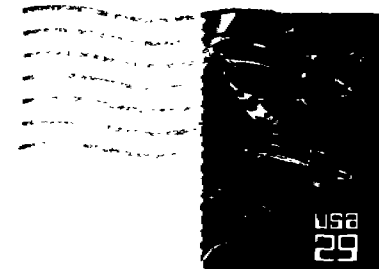
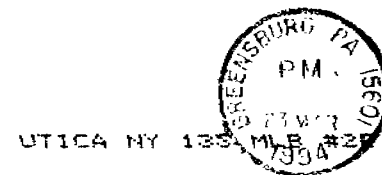
