I purchase this weapon several years ago. It is a fine weapon, but the last 2 or 3 years I have had problems with the weapon firing when I inject a new shell into the Chamber. The first time it happened to me on a deer stand. I had loaded the weapon with a shell in the chamber, when I tried to fire it, it felt like the trigger had already been pulled when I ejected that shell and as the new shell enter the chamber it fired, no trigger fingers were on the trigger. This happen twice. On two other occasions it fired while I was unloading it.

I took it to a gun shop twice to get them to correct it. Both times they said it was OK.

You can take the weapon and target practice with it and it is OK. It seems to happen when I am hunting and have not fired the weapon for

a period of time. It seems to me like the trigger mechanism is not holding the firing pin. I was going to trade it off, but I got to thinking that this weapon would hurt somebody. This is why I called Mr Roger Potter. He referred me to you.

I am really afraid to hunt this weapon or sell it. I would like to get my confidence back in this weapon.
