I purchased the rifle (model 700 BOL,
686 ~~00~~ 13) in Alamogordo N.M. in

1975. Over the last 19 yrs the rifle

has inadvertently fired 3 times when I
went from safe to fire to unload the

rifle. I always point the weapon away

anyone when unloading so no injuries were

even sustained, however it is quite disconcerting
for the rifle to discharge unexpectedly. During

the 3 instances I am 100% positive

my finger was no where near the trigger. The segment on 60 minutes described my situation exactly & my rifle fits the time frame ^{also} described.
