Dear Mr Nagle

I have sent you the Model 700 22-250 Varmint Rifle that I wrote to you about. The problem with the rifle is that it fires accidentally sometimes when you push the safety off. This does not happen often but it has happened on several occasions since I bought the gun. I have only used the gun once in the last couple of years because I do not trust it.

When I talked to you on the telephone you asked me to send you a note to the affect that even if the rifle can be fixed that I would like to have you give me the value of the gun towards a new model 700 B.D.L. in a 7mm 08 or a243 caliber. The reason for this as I stated in my letter is that I really don,t want to keep this rifle at all I just don,t trust it.
