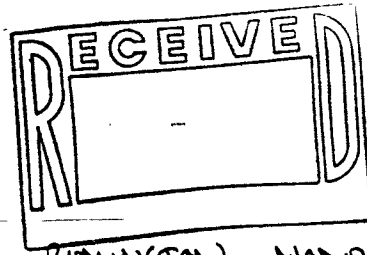


MR. SIRS:
