I believe you had a recall on some Remington Model 600's because they might fire when the safety was released. I had no problem with mine. I tried several times, empty of course, to see if I could cause such a misfire and could not. I did not write to see if my rifle was included in the recall as you suggested.

Recently after cleaning and lubricating my rifle, I noticed that when I raised and lowered the bolt the firing pin went forward as the bolt was closed. I put the safety on and the firing pin stayed back as the bolt was closed. When I pushed the safety off, the rifle fired (empty of course),
