I have owned this Remington 700BDL for 40 years but have only used it the last 5 years. Last November 2009, on a hunting trip to Montana, I had a problem with chambering a round. When I closed the bolt, the firearm discharged on its own. No one was injured but we were shook up a little.

I called Remington immediately when I got back and I was told by a Remington agent that my rifle had been on a recall list for a long time. I hope that after fixing this rifle, you can guarantee that this won't happen again, and restore my faith in your product. Right now I am leery of Remington, and frankly a bit shocked that this happened.
