Another time when he was unloading it with the muzzle down toward the floor board to allow the cartridges to dmp into a clean seat instead of the ground. He had bumped the shells from the bottom, reached to push the safety off to cycle the bolt to empty the chamber and it fired. It blew a hole in the floorboard and destroyed a tire and wheel on

I understand CNBC is biased. Of that I am sure. I can't stand the commie sons-a-bitches. I do agree with you -- that they didn't air their program out of some sense of rightness, but rather -- their overwhelming desire to push an anti-gun agenda. I get that. But they didn't lie about everything. Exaggerate? Yes. Manufacture evidence? Probably. Seek out people who were more than willing to say what CNBC wanted to hear? Absolutely. BUT, there is some truth to the 700s being defective. Mine is!

Let me say that again. MY 700 is DEFECTIVE! It's never been altered. It's never been modified. It has ALWAYS been properly maintained.

I remember the day my father bought this rifle. I believe he bought it new at a store called Furr's that was going out of business in Borger, TX. My father's name was James Robert "Bob" Lusk. He didn't hunt much, or even shoot much, but he loved this rifle as much as any possession he'd ever owned. He presented the rifle to me around 1983 -- I've had the rifle ever since. As far as I know, he and I are the only two people to ever shoot this rifle. He would never loan it out, nor would I.

I don't know if the rifle ever discharged inadvertently with dad, (he has been dead for several years now) he never mentioned it, if it did. I do remember him buying 6 or 8 boxes of ammo for it when he bought the rifle. When he gave me the rifle, he also gave me no less than 6 boxes of the original ammo. At best, he fired less than 40 rounds through it before he presented it to me.

The rifle has twice discharged live ammunition inadvertently with me. Once down range harmlessly, while I was shouldering it to shoot a deer. I pushed the safety off, and BOOM, it fired. It inadvertently fired again while unloading it barrel down toward the floorboard of my daughter's truck. I used to routinely unload the rifle in the seat - muzzle down toward the floor board, allowing the cartridges to dump into a clean seat, rather than taking a chance on letting them fall into the dirt. I had dumped the shells from the bottom. I reached to push the safety off, to cycle the bolt, to empty the chamber, and again, BOOM! It blew a hole in the floorboard and destroyed a tire and wheel. Both occurrences left me thinking I was an idiot and had done something to cause both incidents. I soon figured out, that was not the case.

A few years after the 2nd incident, upon reassembly after cleaning the rifle, it dry fired inadvertently. The rifle dry fired every time I cycled and set the bolt. Over and over, it did this -- a couple dozen times or more. I pulled it back apart several times, cleaned, oiled, used compressed air to blow it clean and dry, cursed, cleaned and air blew some more. Finally, it started cycling properly. Next day, we were going hunting. I cycled the bolt before loading the rifle, and it inadvertently dry fired several times before finally holding the pin in fire position. I cursed again -- I simply could not trust this rifle. I placed the rifle back in the truck without ever loading it. It hasn't been fired or even loaded since. It is defective, period. Like I said, it's never been modified and has always been well maintained.

Bear in mind, the rifle may fire properly a hundred times without malfunctioning. I fired hundreds of rounds through this rifle before, between and after the two accidental live fire discharges, right up to the time it inadvertently dry fired after cleaning. Believe me, sooner or later, you keep messing with it -- and it WILL discharge inadvertently. Do not send this rifle back to me, until it is safe to use. I pray this rifle will answer some questions and help you solve the mystery of this problem.
