Problems :

- 1) Bolt will not close. This model has a j slot security system. However I do not have a key for the slot and have never used this system. In any case the red dot is showing from the rear.
- 2) When using the rifle, on two occasions I have closed the bolt without touching the trigger and when the bolt closed the round went off.
- 3) The trigger is set so lite that that if you just touch it, the round will go off.

Thank You for your attention to my issues. I own 2 other Remington Rifles (700 BDL and 700P) and 2 Remington Shotguns (2 -1100's) and love the products.
