

## Remington,

As per my conversation with Greg at customer service I am returning my Remington .308 ADL rifle, SN# 222781 for inspection. I bought this rifle used about ten years or more ago and have hunted with it extensively and have not experienced any problems.

A short synopsis of what happened was: After a trip to Kansas, I returned home to Colorado, but left this rifle with a friend to use in Kansas. He assured me that he did not have time to use it and did not even take it out of the case or use any of the ammunition I had left for him. He just brought it back to Colorado.

So I just went to oil it before returning it to my gun safe. Upon closing the bolt, the firing pin followed. I cocked the bolt and closed it again and the firing fin followed. I then cocked the bolt, engaged the safety, closed the bolt, then took the safety off, at which time the firing pin followed. Had there been a round in the chamber it would have fired. I'm glad my friend did not have time to hunt. And I have not been able to duplicate this since.

Please don't get me wrong, I'm not bashing Remington products. I am a big fan of Remington rifles and shotguns. I currently own four Remington rifles and three Remington shotguns. I would buy another rifle or shotgun, should I need one.

I also used them professionally, as I am a retired police officer from New Jersey and used Remington sniper rifles on the Bergen County Police SWAT Team for years. And I have attended your shotgun armorer's course in Massachusetts.

I just don't want to experience an unintended discharge, which could cause property or bodily injury; therefore I contacted Remington for advice.

If the trigger group is replaced, is it possible to keep the current safety lever, as it appears more the era it was manufactured? If not that's alright also.
