This rifle has performed very well in the 15 years I've owned it, and as you can see, is well cared for. I realze that a fifteen year old firearm is probably not under any kind warranty; however, considering the dangerous nature of this malfunction, I have returned it with the following suggestions:

1) I'd prefer that Remington replace this rifle. This may seem odd, but repairing the problem and returning it to me would prove unsatisfactory. I would be very uncomfortable using this rifle again, considering the nature of the malfunction. Another concern is that I had planned to take this rifle on a kayak trip down the 1,800 mile length of the Yukon River during the summer of 1997 as "bear protection". I'm not comfortable bringing this gun. If replacing it is an option, I an willing to pay the difference between this gun and another model 700 with the following spec's: .338 Win. Mag with composite stock, equipped with iron sights.

2) If replacement is not possible, please repair the rifle malfunction and return it.
