
Dear John Rodgers,

I am writing in regards to the enclosed Remington 700 police rifle and an accidental discharge that occurred on November 8, 1997. While at the range during a demonstration, I had three rounds in the weapon, and believed that firing had concluded for the day. I opened the bolt and took out the round that had been in chamber, when I was told to fire one more round. I closed the bolt on the remaining two rounds, which seated properly. I pushed the bolt handle down with the palm of my right hand, without my fingers or any debris entering the trigger guard or reaching the trigger. When I firmly closed the bolt home and pushed the bolt handle to its locked position, a round was discharged. The weapon, of course, was in the fire, not safe, mode. After firing my round, I secured the weapon and placed it in a safe condition, leaving my shooting area.

Afterwards, several students were given the opportunity to fire the rifle, shooting approximately 40 rounds through the weapon. No further incidents occurred. I have fired approximately 2,000 rounds in the rifle and have had it in my sole possession since my department purchased it new. I lubricate it only with RemOil and clean it only with RemClean.
