Sniper recently experienced an unintentional discharge with the enclosed weapon, Remington Model 700, serial C6671256, when he was pushing the bolt into battery on a live round. Fortunately the weapon was pointed at the ground and the weapon discharged harmlessly into the ground. The officer said he was using his right hand to push the bolt home and was no where near the trigger at the time of discharge. We are requesting a complete examination and repair/adjustment as necessary. Please notify me of the estimated cost prior to performing the needed repairs.

I have talked to another agency in the area and they claim to have suffered a similar event. We are wondering if the weapon should be sent in on a regular basis, perhaps after so many rounds, for a regular adjustment/inspection to prevent this type of accident. Please advise.
