Dear Sir

Please find enclosed a Remington Model 700- 25-06. This rifle has on two separate occasions fired as the bolt was being grasped while preparing to unload a live round. On both occasions the safety was disengaged and the bolt handle was touched prior to lifting the bolt handle when the rifle somehow fired.

The first time this occurred we were leaving the field and as we were unloading our weapons this one went off. We immediately took the rifle to a gunsmith and he checked it over and found nothing wrong. He suggested that perhaps a weed seed had lodged in the mechanism and caused the problem.

The second time though was at the range and I had cleaned the rifle to the best of my ability including using rather light air pressure on the trigger mechanism to be sure it was free of particles. I had fired approx. 50 rounds when I tried to again eject a live round and it fired again on its own.
