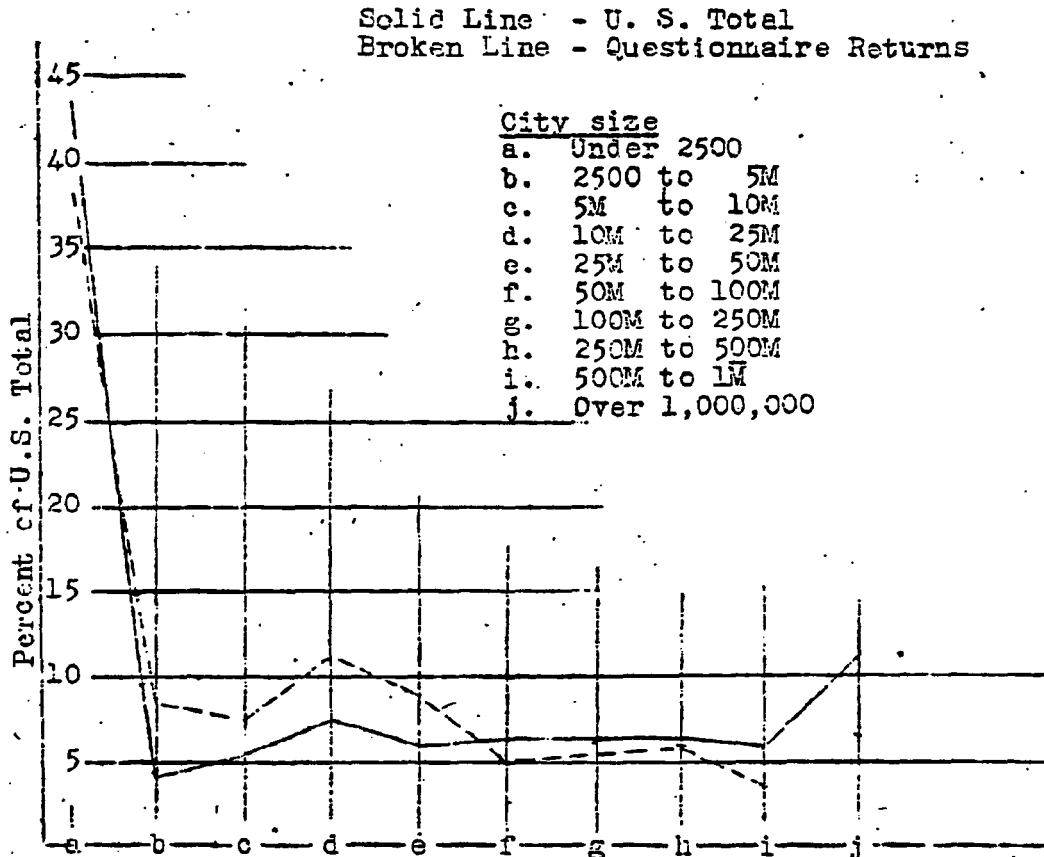


3. Returns by size of cities

The returns originated in towns and cities of various sizes in approximately the same ratio as the population of different city sizes bears to the total continental United States population.

4. Farmers constitute 13.85% of all employed males (1940 census) and questionnaires received from farmers were 14.21% of total returns.

5. Returns by shooters' "ratings"

Sportsmen were asked to classify themselves under four groups - gun "nut", regular, occasional, or infrequent shooter. The results:
