

12. That take-down rifle frames are more preferred than solid frames

The over-all response is as follows:

13. That about half the respondents want their rifles checkered.

For all questionnaire returns, the findings are:

"Checker both fore-end and grip"	25.9
"Don't care whether rifle is checkered or not"	27.2
"Don't" want checkering"	14.3
"Checker fore-end only"	9.7
"Checker grip only"	2.9

Preferences vary by shooters' ratings, by age groups, by the amount sportsmen think a rifle should cost, and by caliber -- 22's as against center fire rifles. These tabulations follow:
