

50% of these two classes of shooters specify larger than present fore-ends on shotguns.

9. The development of a top-of-grip sliding catch rifle safety would apparently result in an appealing and distinctive feature in Remington rifles and thus lift these arms to greater popularity.
10. The sliding catch safety dominates the single, double barrel, and over-and-under designs of shotguns and is of considerable interest in connection with pump and autoloading shotguns.
11. Sling straps and swivels on center fire rifles are desired by 63% of the respondents; other "extras" aren't particularly popular.

Recommendations

Based upon the foregoing conclusions and upon the data detailed in this report, the following possibilities seem worthy of study by the Products Committee:

As to rifles:

1. That the Remington post war line include: (*)
 - a. Rim fire 22 caliber rifles in autoloading, pump and bolt actions
 - b. Bolt action center fire rifles:
 1. 30-06
 2. 270 Winchester
 3. 257 Roberts
 4. 30-30
 5. 22 Hornet
 6. 300 Magnum
 7. 250-3000
 8. 35 Remington
 9. 375 Magnum
 - c. Pump action center fire rifles:
 1. 35 Remington
 2. 30-30
 3. 300 Savage
 4. 30 Remington
 5. 30-06

(*) This listing does not contain any lever action rifles. This for the reason that lever action arms are less popular than bolt, pump, or autoloading rifles.
