Your letter dated 2-7-46 recommends that the Sear for the Model 721-722 rifle be purchased from the Powdered Metal Products, Inc. of Chicago, Illinois, and that it should be made from powdered metal. Since we have received this letter, no information has been sent relative to new material procurement sheets and relative to the condition in which these parts will be purchased. It is suggested that this information be transmitted to the plant immediately since no information can be sent to the Planning and Purchasing Department from this group until all information is on hand.

No information has been received to date telling us to hold up purchasing of the Sear as transmitted to us previously. Is it your intention to withdraw these specifications as previously received or merely to offer the powdered metal part as an alternate.
