SUBJECT: MODEL 721 SEAR

Your letter of September 18 on the above subject indicates that you have on hand in raw stores 500 pieces of the subject component made of powdered metal. It is also indicated that you have charged into raw stores a sum amounting to \$1200 covering the development of tools used by the supplier for manufacturing these parts. Inasmuch as these parts have been superseded and are of no use whatsoever to the Plant, it is believed that the proper procedure for relieving your accounts consists of obtaining a Plant Order from G. L. Smith of Technical to cover the scrapping of the material and the writing off of the tool charge. It is suggested that this matter be handled directly between your department and the Technical Group.
