

We charges or credits should be involved in this instance since the cartridges were made by the Ammunition Development Section of the Bridgeport Technical Department for use in the development of the M/721-722 rifle. Whether the charges were transferred to the Ilion project or whether they remained in the Ammunition Development Section is irrelevant, since in any event the work was Research Class &-II and, as which, does not go into mill cost.
