Page 1 - Cover The revision date must be changed to 10-1-53

Page 2 Under paragraph heading "TO LOAD MAGAZINE:" the wording "and five in the .222 Cal Remington" should follow the word "(Magnum)".

Pages 5 and 6 will be eliminated and the sectional view on Page 4 will substitute. (The art work plate of the sectional view is submitted with minor changes in the parts labelling). Immediately below the sectional view add the attached precautionary paragraph related to the restriction of parts for parts sales.

It will be necessary to close up the copy under the paragraph "CARE OF RIFLE" with the sentence "Interior of barrel should be cleaned free of grease before firing to prevent obstructing the passage of the bullet" being eliminated because this precaution is mentioned elsewhere in the folder. This elimination will assist in the close-up of this copy to provide additional space for insertion of the precautionary paragraph.

When ordering parts, specify model, caliber, part name, and serial number of gun.

NOTE: The sale of barrel assemblies (includes receiver), and bolt assemblies is restricted. When these parts are needed for replacement, the arm must be returned to the factory as the use of special tools and gauges is required to assure proper operation. All other parts will be shipped as ordered but, since they are made to close dimensions, the particular part may require slight adjustment or fitting to assure proper functioning of the arm.
