Dear Captain Maiman:

We thank you for your letter of August 22, 1956 which was forwarded to us by Ziniuk and Company, Ltd., with their letter of August 31, 1956. We are particularly appreciative of your continued interest in the improvement of our Model 40 X Rifle.

We are arraid that the modification you propose would result in increased motion of the sear parts with such motion apparent to the trigger finger and in considerably increased look time. In our judgment, the undesirable effect of this modification would outweigh those factors which you feel should be corrected in the Model 40 X trigger meshanismé

We have a continuing program for the further development of this and other models of our firearms. This program, however, runs into conflicting desires on the part of our customers and the production design must at times be a compromise which we hope will satisfy the greatest number of shooters. As an example, you are "free rifle minded" while comparatively few shooters in the United States are so inclined, and to make one rifle accomplish what both groups want is difficult.

Should you have further ideas on this subject we will be glad to consider them, but believe that we should suggest that for your own protection you carefully consider the adequacy with which you have protected your patent rights and perhaps limit your suggestions to those items on which you have protected your patent rights by obtaining a patent or filing a patent application.
