INTRODUCTION

The Models 721-722 Center Fire Rifles were introduced in 1948. These rifles became very popular with the trade, and sales were outstanding for a number of years after introduction for this type of rifle.

The stocks on these rifles have been furnished with an optional specification for either a high comb or low comb depending on whether or not to be used for telescope or open sights. The variations have increased inventories and resulted in some dissatisfaction on the part of the salesmen and purchasers of these models, especially with the low comb, which is furnished with a high comb stock unless specified otherwise. This grade is fitted with standard open sights, resulting in a sight line which is unsuitable for most shooters when so equipped with telescopic sight.

Another improvement requested by Sales Department is a new Safety. Despite the changes made to the finger piece in 1953, the Safety was still not considered adequate; therefore an entirely new design has been made for the safety lever together with a linkage which permits use of the existing fire control.

After careful consideration and investigation into the sight lines of the Center Fire Rifles, the Sales Department has requested that the new "All Purpose" Stock be designed; one which would be suitable for use with either open or telescopic sights. Sample models have been built for the Models 740-760 and for the long stock Model 725 (except for the Monte Carlo feature) and approved by the Sales Department.

INTRODUCTION

A project has been prepared for the Models 740-760 in order to accomplish a center sight line that is approximately the same height as that for the more popular telescopic and mount combinations.

The Models 721-722 Center Fire Rifle modification program will include a new sight along with new sights, etc.
