MODEL 40X REMINGTON 22 CALIBER 22 TARGET RIFLE
FOR UNITED STATES ARMY ORDNANCE - #161
References: Your letter dated March 5, 1958

We have reviewed the U.S. Army request for Proposal or Invitation to bid on furnishing the 40X Model 22 Caliber Remington Target Rifle. It appears that based on the information furnished in their proposal, our standard commercial M/40X 22 Cal. Target Rifle would meet their specifications. Therefore, on this assumption we would be able to make delivery on any of the following models, two or three days after receipt of orders:

Model 40X S1 Standard Barrel with Redfield Olympic Sights
" 40X S2 " " without sights
" 40X F1 Heavy Barrel with Redfield Olympic Sights
" 40X E2, " " without sights

Since the specifications as furnished specify only the Model 40X with heavy Barrel, solid Receiver, less slings, it is impossible to furnish information other than the above. No mention has been made in regard to special Government Roll Marking, special packing, Target & Test, or any other such requirements. Therefore, it has been assumed that one of the models as shown above meeting standard commercial specifications would be acceptable. Otherwise our delivery schedule and Factory Costs would be affected.

We tried to reach you today by phone, however you were out of town and no one available could furnish any definite information in regard to same.

If we can be of further assistance, please advise.
