With Curt Romey we fired about 1 0 shots at 50 and 100 yards. Accuracy was good. Would like t. try this cut with a telescope sight.

Nylon handle is good; however, the drooping sytel at the mussle is not a good testimonial to plastic stocks. This should be reinforced so that the fore-end matches with the barrel better.

We found the trigger pull a little over one lb. which is nice and crisp but not safe. We found that by tapping the front end of the receiver with a plastic hammer the gun would fire. The gun will also fire when tapped briskly with a plastic hammer at the mussle. In other words, if this gun were dropped with the safety off, it will fire.

The slippery carrying case is worthless without "D" type carrying handles. Either one of the following gum.case makers in Cleveland may give you a fair price on handles:
