 rounds. Encountered no mal-functions
 of any kind. Accuracy extremely good, also
 handling and appearance qualities. Final
ready and I am sure this is to be
 expected due to weight. Muzzle blast
 not in excess to "man behind" gun.

Considering price & etc., appearance very good.

Sight bases not available for
 scope mount, therefore did not use scope
 in testing.

Recommendations or suggestions for change

①. Some simple type of adjustment for windage
 and elevation on Rear Sight, eliminating
 the allen wrench, making it possible for
 a better - easier - more accurate adjustment
 for all types of consumers.

②. Two drilled and tapped holes for rear

My reason for recommending that
two holes be drilled and tapped for rear
base mount, is to offer a more secure
and stronger mount as is in all
other of our Rifles and Cartridges.
