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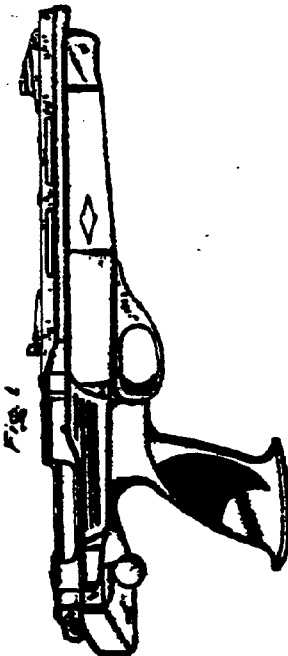

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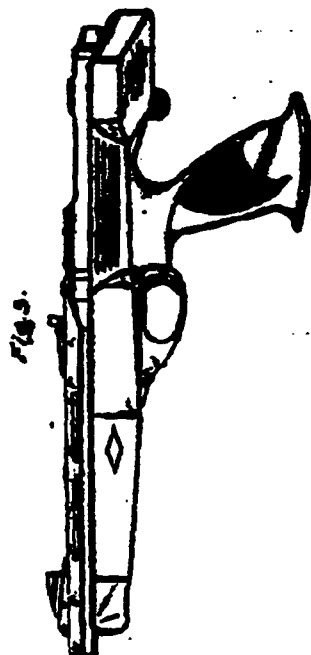


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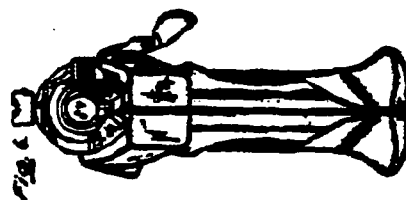
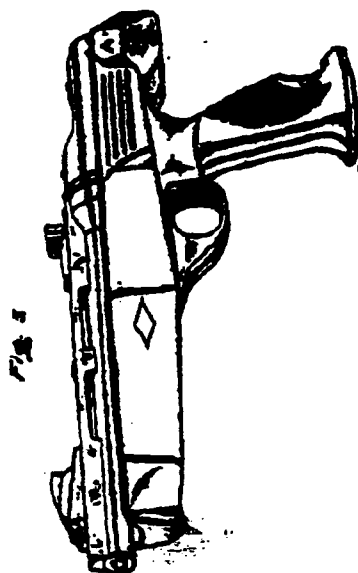

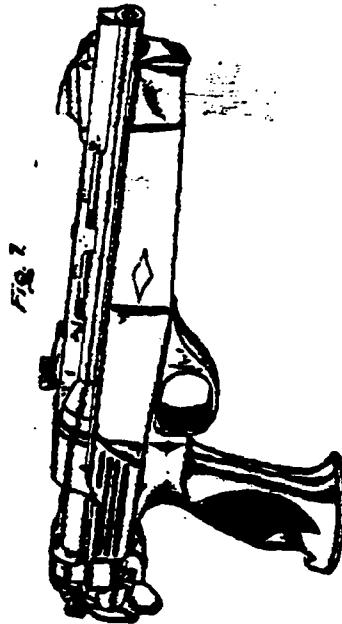
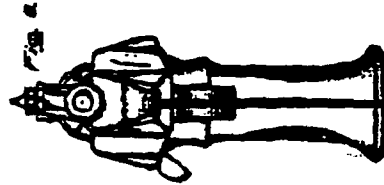


FIG. 1 is a side view of the right side of the firearm showing our new design;
