MAGAZINE SUPPORT

The M/600 Magazine Support has been eliminated and drawings affecting such have been transmitted.

The original purpose of the support was to hold a loaded magazine in position while the barreled receiver, without stock, was test fired in the accuracy device; however, rifle is presently test fired completely assembled.

Testing did not show any problems in functioning that would be caused by this change. This change will result in:

Elimination of two parts, the support and support screw.

Elimination of the magazine assembly spot welding operation.


Eliminate a hole drilled and tapped in the receiver.

Eliminate the stock cut and strengthen stock.

Eliminate final assembly operation.

Some favorable opinion has been expressed by a few gunsmiths on the support as it makes the complete assembly easier to handle out of the stock. However, the elimination of the support will reduce costs and strengthen the M/600, and should justify this change.
