MODEL 700, 22-250 REMINGTON CALIBER

Confirming the review with Sales of the preliminary economics for the proposed 22-250 caliber, it was agreed that the initial presentation will be on the basis of adding this caliber to the Model 700, ADL and BDL. The volumes for the estimated economics will be 900 for the ADL and 400 for the BDL.

At the present time, Sales questions the advisability of adding the Model 700 Special. This would have been a gun which would require custom shop work. The proposed gun would have had a stainless steel Barrel with a contour approximately the same as the Model 40X-B standard weight gun. Sights would not have been provided, however, the Barrel would have been supplied with scope mounts the same as the Model 40X-B.
