Dear Vic:

Mike Walker just passed your memo concerning your problem with the Model 600 over to me. I'll try to help you out as best I can.

As long as you have a Redfield receiver sight and it is satisfactory for your rifle, it will take care of the front sight by providing one approximately an 1/8 of an inch lower in dimensions. For old fogies like you (and don't forget you were the one who said that), the best way to equip the Model 600 with adequate sighting equipment other than existing sights presented would be to use the long eye relief scope that is being provided for this rifle by the Redfield Gun Sight Company or the new Leupold which has been recently developed for long eye relief use. These two companies are in the process of developing mounts which will fasten on to the front V-ring and barrel bracket and one of the studs on the rib and I would say that in the next three to six months this equipment will be available for the forward mounting purposes. Then you can adjust the eye piece to fit your own eye and have available all the ejection port for it for feeding and ejection of shells without interference with the scope mount or scope.

I hope this combination and the one you have, plus the sight that I am sending, will be sufficient for your purposes.

Nice writing to you Vic. Let's hear how you've been doing over the past years. I believe the last time I saw you was in Detroit where you were an extremely fine host at the Williams meeting and I appreciate all you did for me at that time.
