Model 700 Varmint

Accuracy specifications were set at 1-1/2" for all calibers except the .243.

The .243 specification is 2". Improvement to 1" as requested by Marketing may eventually be attained by adequate repair and maintenance of the shooting devices plus improvements in the rifle and ammunition. Model drawings are being transmitted.

M/700 and 40-XB Cost Reduction

Cost reduction economics are being accumulated slowly. More important work takes precedence. Items involved are wood price (birch), trigger nousing (new riveted construction), firing pin (sew blanked and cold headed part), sear (powder metal), and telescope blocks (powder metal). In addition, the M/40x8 stock has been altered to require fewer second operations.

No progress. Delays have been experienced in obtaining birch blanks.
