Dear Mr. Kennelly:

We have your letter of July 5 concerning your Model 700 BDL 22-250 caliber rifle.

We note you wish to adjust the trigger pull to about one pound, but this model as produced by us has been checked and adjusted for a trigger pull of a bare minimum of four pounds and maximum of six pounds. We feel this to be consistent with safety for a high powered rifle of this sort.

We do not feel that it would be any particular advantage for you to install the 40 XB standard trigger and we would not recommend it for a general type of hunting rifle.

We are enclosing a parts list for the 40-XB 22 caliber and center fire rifle and have inserted the prices covering the various types of trigger assemblies.

We trust this is the information desired.
