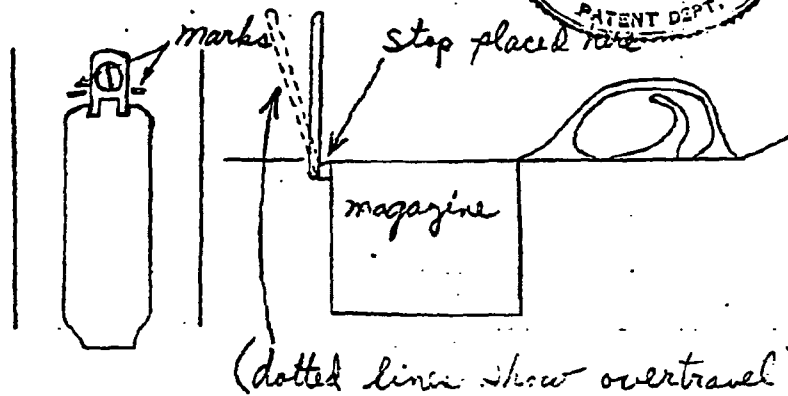
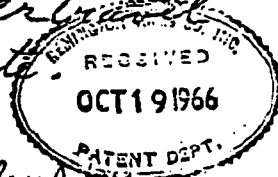
Dear Sirs:
