SUBJECT: M/660 FIELD TEST & FEATURES

A total of 40 rounds should be sufficient to test this new bolt action center fire rifle for function and accuracy.

The 308 Win. will be produced, first, from a caliber line which includes also 222 Rem., 6MM Rem., 243 Win., 6.5MM Rem. Mag., and 350 Rem. Mag.

The M/660 is basically the M/600 type action, re-styled with the following features:

Barrel - 20 inch, Magnum weight for all calibers to improve accuracy.  
No barrel rib.

Sights - Open M/700 type, removable front and rear.

Barrel Bracket - Elevated for telescope mount back-up.

Receiver - Same as M/600 with (3) sight holes on top radius, (2) on left rear for receiver sight.

Bolt - Same as M/600 except black handle, handle section and front lug section.  
Middle bolt body "bright steel". A hooded bolt plug encloses firing pin head at rear of bolt.
