NOTES ON ABOVE SUMMARY:

KINZER V. REMINGTON

- 1. The Division Lanager's Secretary also carries the majority of work load for The Firearms Design Group. This situation is somewhat overloaded and not too practical.
- 2. Project Control: With the loss of the Supervisor this work has been picked up by additional training and effort of the Clerk, and by adding a typist clerk. Renathing load has been spread to each of the Section Hanagers and a little more help from the Division Hanager. This is now working reasonably well however, believe that an Accountant may be needed in reserve. There is one who may aspire to the job, and now located in the Powder Letal Group.
- 3. Technical Services: This group includes the Supervisor of Current Lodels Program (R.P. Helly). Finnegan is approaching retirement. Frank Mart is used part time by the Design Group. The Detailer, Gloria Polley, is used part time on Stenographic work, account of vacations, illnesses, or extra work loads in the other Sections.

- 4. Firearms Design: Empanded by net of five (5) since Jan. 1st. This expected to handle the new Shotgun program and to organize and train for the Computer and M/C programs. W. Dahl was first transferred to Walker, and later lost a designer (Waterman) by resignation. Also lost an ESD Engineer (Sankey). Another Designer (Sanzo) is being transferred from Custon Shop group. Designer (banzo) is being transferred from custom shop group. Three (3) MageRoll employees have been hired or transferred as Jr. Draftsmen, students, in training. A new Laboratory Technician has been employed to replace one (Curry) who has been moved from the Test Lab. unit into the Computer & N/C Unit. We still have one (1) unfilled Employment Authorization for a Research Engineer, requested for the Computer & N/C Programs.
- 5. Model Shop: Little Change here. The Foreman (Williams) retired and has been replaced by J. Bechard (Acting). One Hodel maker was transferred to the I/C unit. Replacements have been made with employees in training to balance the above changes.
- 6. Custom Shop: Little change here in "numbers". An emerionced machine operator is still needed for Barrel work (Wage). A Draftsman "By was hired and in training. Another is needed to replace "rented designer" from Premier Engineering Co.
- 7. Powder Retal: Wage Roll Empansion with consolidation from plant and as tools and equipment become available to fill orders. One Engineer (Brown) transferred back to plant, replacing a Foreman (Reddell), moved into the FizDense Division. One new Stenographer employed to replace M. Bridger, who will go on leave for pregnancy, Nov. 1st. This roll also includes F. G. du Pont, located in Bridgeport. Shortage of DieMakers.
- 8. "Alcet": No changes . Lachining work being done by Plant Tool
 Room and by Assist from Lachine Development Hodel Maker.

 9. Machine Development: The summary includes three (3) on
 the DuPont Roells, and Che "Rented Designer", scheduled to be
 replaced by Covember 15th. Not included is one wage roll
 employee, (Deller), who was transferred to Production, anticincipating the Stock Press Forming job going on the line. Since
 this has been delayed, presumeably this man's cost is being charged to Ran.
