MODEL 700 IMPROVEMENTS - RIGHT AND LEFT HAND

Following is the list of improvements for the Model 700 rifle. Product cost for each improvement should be estimated separately as if it were a single project. Marketing is to evaluate each improvement and determine which ones are to be added. A project should be submitted in early October for the selected improvements.

The following are to be introduced as soon as available:

1. New Rear Sight - Project approved.
2. New solid steel Follower.
3. New non-vented Recoil Pad for magnum rifles.
4. Improved metal finish.
5. New 1/8" forward Bolt Handle.

The following improvements are to be introduced in January, 1974 with warehouse in September, 1973:

6. New Stock with cut checkering. New Fore-end Tip and Spacer, Grip Cap and Spacer, Butt Plate and Spacer.
7. New Receiver and Bolt with anti-jind device. This includes revisions to the:

Receiver  
Bolt Head  
Bolt Body Assembly  
Barrel Assembly


This device will be included in the Model 40XB.

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7. contd.

Since there will not be a common Bolt Head, a tooling change is required for the Mohawk 600 and XP-100 Bolt Head.

8. Reduced lock time. This is a lighter Firing Pin only.
9. Full shroud over Firing Pin head (new Bolt Plug) and Cocking Indicator on Firing Pin head.
