Please refer to my March 30 letter concerning Boustead Wood Pty. Ltd.'s problems with two of our rifles. On April 9 Mike Walker phoned the following memo to Herb Albaugh.

" Mike Walker called to say there was no way to use longer trigger adjusting screws on the M/700 to accommodate a lock-nut per the Australian ruling. They are now working on a way to make trigger non-adjustable except as a factory job. However, he says we have to improve trigger pull set at plant before we do so."

These people are still in a quandry as to what to do about the impounded Remington guns. Should we ask for the return of these guns at our expense? Should production become involved with this problem too?
