PLASTICS RESEARCH

The order for urethane tip studs for the Nylon 66 welding fixture has been completed and turned over to production:

Safety rods for M/3200 assembly are still being processed. This is to use remaining dowels and provide a bank for future demands.

Another lot of base pads have been received from the N/C job and processing of M/540X butt pads is being done. These are in addition to the schedule and will provide a surplus for future problems.

A new application for urethane is being tried. The application is similar to the clamp fixture and experimental parts have been made and are being tried.
