a trip was made to visit 12 Gun Repair stations
concerning the model 600 recall program.

Reception at all gun repair stations was very
good. They were all glad to see someone from Pennington
to go over the recall program, all stations had received
at least 5 trigger assemblies with about half of them
having received a second 5. The first five assemblies were
individually wrapped. The second five were wrapped together in one
package. One assembly had a slange pin missing but was
still intact.

Some of the stations did not ^{completely} understand that serial
numbers with the A & B prefix were not included in the
recall program and a few had changed trigger assemblies in
rifles with an A prefix.

Most of the stations that had X.P. 100 pistols had
been instructed by their customers not to return them to the
factory.
